The next set of cargo and supplies needed by astronauts currently living in the orbiting laboratory has been scheduled to fly on a cargo resupply mission in August, SpaceX officials said. The Dragon spacecraft, which is being readied for launch, is scheduled to make a two-day trip to the orbiting lab, carrying 1,200 pounds of cargo, including new spare parts for the ISS, food and other supplies for the crew and a new science experiment. SpaceX is aiming to repeat the feat, with a delivery mission scheduled for later this year. "We're very excited to continue the supply chain with a resupply mission for the International Space Station," said Gary Wentz, SpaceX's vice president of build and flight reliability. "It's a significant milestone in getting back to regularly sending people to the ISS." SpaceX first launched a Dragon capsule in May 2010, ferrying cargo and supplies to the space station. It then launched a cargo resupply mission in September 2011 and again in April 2012. SpaceX has contracted to fly at least 12 resupply missions for NASA between 2013 and 2016. A contract with Orbital Sciences for a similar number of missions has not yet been signed. The next resupply mission, due in late August, will carry many of the same

The series stars Zhang Hanyu, Gao Weiguo, Chang Hui, Liang Xuan and Li Qiang. It is based on the novel of the same name written by Guo Moruo, with additional stories by Liu Baoyu. The series originally aired on Hunan Television between February 10, 1995 and March 30, 1995. It was the first collaboration between the two filmmakers and the first time Chen Kaige directed a television series. It was his directorial debut and he also starred in the series. The series received positive reviews and is considered to be a seminal television series in China's television industry. Cast Zhang Hanyu as Liu Hu Gao Weiguo as Wang Ying Chang Hui as Xiao Xian Liang Xuan as Ling Qiu Li Qiang as Mei Gong Production The series was Chen Kaige's directorial debut. He was only 26 years old at the time and he was impressed by the novel written by Guo Moruo, one of the pioneers of modern Chinese literature. Chen was influenced by the work of master filmmaker and philosopher Chen Liting, who had also directed one of Chen Kaige's films, Yellow Earth (1988), a film that Chen is said to consider to be his masterpiece. Chen also cited as inspiration filmmakers such as Akira Kurosawa, Satyajit Ray and Yasujirō Ozu. Chen hired Wang Yuedan as scriptwriter for the series, a former radio scriptwriter who was previously a researcher of modern Chinese literature.
